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




Allogeneic HCTs in the U.S. by Race and Ethnicity






U.S. Allogeneic HCT by Ethnicity



Entanglement of factors impede access to HCT/CT









VISION:



Caregiver Reimagined

- **Problem:** Caregiver requirement poses challenges for many patients who lack social support or financial means to secure a caregiver, potentially denying them access to alloHCT.
- Project: Reimagining Caregiving Together: Engagement to Address Caregiver Requirement Barriers
 - -- Patient-Centered Outcomes Research Institute (PCORI) Eugene Washington Engagement Award Program

Project Aims:

- -- Convene and engage a diverse group of **stakeholders** to discuss challenges and solutions to the caregiver requirement as an HCT barrier
- -- Identify and prioritize research questions, interventions and engagement plans to develop a patient-centered CER agenda
- -- Prepare convened stakeholders to promote and support the patientcentered CER agenda to **advance systems change**



Assessing Diversity in the HCT/CT Workforce

- No baseline diversity data exist in HCT/CT workforce
- Junior Faculty Immersion Group designed the inaugural ecosystem-wide workforce diversity survey
- 18Q, multi-choice survey → N=432 (Physicians n=179)
 - -- Position, academic rank
 - -- Age, relationship profile, self-identified pronouns and communities
 - -- Racial and ethnicity, fluent languages spoken
 - -- Family background (parent/guardian marital status, education level)
 - -- International medical graduate (IMG) status
 - -- Treatment center location, patient race and ethnicity, WFD assessment
- ASTCT & PTCTC email distribution list
- Publish on results and use as benchmark to measure changes



Recommendation 5: Polices that Provide Financial Assistance and Workplace Protection and Appropriate Medical Coverage for Transplant Caregivers

"A recent study of medical coverage for hematopoietic cell transplantation (HCT) among Medicaid beneficiaries found inequities in support for patients and their caregivers resulting in significant financial burden.⁹⁴

The study revealed variations and gaps in coverage for caregiver expenses and payments/reimbursements for out-of-pocket expenses despite transportation, meals, and lodging expenses are covered by Medicaid in most states. For example, some states restrict coverage for expenses only when the Medicaid beneficiary is a child and/or only when admitted as an inpatient."


